Garbage and Rubbish – Weekly Pick-Up

Garbage: All animal and vegetable waste connected with the preparation of foods for human consumption, all non-recyclable packaging of food and household products and all materials used in the preparation and handling of food.

Rubbish: Rags, crockery, broken glass, waste basket debris, furniture, clothing, porcelain, waste paper, and other similar materials from dwelling units.

All garbage/rubbish items must be bagged and fit within City issued toter.

*****Large/Bulk Pickup Items*** Picked up on TUESDAYS (based on your trash pick-up day)**

1st Tues. (Monday's Route), 2nd Tues. (Wednesday's Route), 3rd Tues. (Thursday's Route), 4th Tues. (Friday's Route)

Furniture: chairs, tables, headboards, sofa, mattresses, interior doors, toilets (must be in 2 pieces) etc.

White Goods: washer, dryer, dishwasher, stove, hot water tank (empty), etc.

*Refrigerators only if Freon is removed and red tagged by service technician! *

Lumber and pipes must be cut in four (4) foot lengths and tied in manageable bundles

Carpeting must be cut, rolled and tied in four (4) foot lengths

Remodeling debris must be in sturdy containers which can be handled by one (1) person and in small quantities

****Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) including electronics – Residential Customers ONLY****

Household Chemicals, Automotive Products, Consumer Electronics, Paint Products, Batteries, Garden Chemicals, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Thermometers and Thermostats, Flammable Items, Syringes and Lancets, Swimming Pool Chemicals, Etc.

Recycling – Biweekly Pick-Up

All recyclable items must be separated from refuse for biweekly pickup at the curb. The following items must be placed in **City issued toter!**

Glass: Bottles and jars – remove lids/rings and rinse with water. No WINDOW glass.

Plastic: Soda bottles, milk and water jugs, detergent or bleach bottles and all other #1 and #2 plastic containers – remove lids and rinse with water. No antifreeze or oil containers.

Metal: Aluminum and bi-metal beverage cans, coffee cans, soup cans and all canned food containers. Remove lids and rinse with water.

Paper: Newspaper, magazines/catalogs, flattened cardboard & paper bags, phone books and paperboard (not wax coated.)

Yard waste such as: tree limbs, trimmings, grass clippings or any yard or garden waste. This will be scheduled for pick-up by the City Public Works Department in April and October only. Leaves should be bagged in the Spring and raked to the curb in fall. DO NOT rake debris into the street.
