

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the City of Corry, in Conjunction with the Erie County Housing Authority, intends to make application with the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for FY 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$307,122 to undertake activities which address community development and/or housing needs which principally benefit low-to-moderate income persons. The amount of funds proposed to benefit low and moderate income persons is not less than 70%.

Based upon a public needs hearing and a review of project requests, the City proposes that its FY 2022 CDBG funds be used for the following activities:

- 1) \$243,122 – Storm Sewer Separation Project
- 2) \$ 40,000 – Code Enforcement Officer Partial Salary
- 3) \$ 24,000 – Program Administration

A final public hearing to discuss how the City proposes to use its FY 2022 CDBG funds is scheduled for 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 15, 2022 at the City Council Chambers, 100 South Center Street, Corry, PA 16407. This facility is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency. To join via Zoom, visit the City of Corry's website, www.corrypa.org, under Meetings select the meeting date and follow steps to connect. The City of Corry will also accept written comments, addressed to the City Building, 100 S. Center St., Corry, PA 16407, on proposed use of 2022 CDBG funds until September 15, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. Corry City Council will consider the approval of the City of Corry's 2022 CDBG application at their regular Council meeting on September 19, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

All citizens of the City of Corry and interested persons are invited to attend the Public Hearing and offer their views and comments concerning the Program and proposed use of the funds, and make other suggestions for the use of these funds.
