A Public Hearing was held in Council Chambers to discuss the 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and seek input from the public as to the proposed uses for this funding. Roll call found Council members, Mr. Sproveri, Mr. Roche, Mr. Fike, Mrs. Lindstrom and Mayor Baker; along with City Administrator Joanne Smith, Fire Chief Hodak, Public Works Manager Leofsky and Beverly Weaver and Lorie Sutton, of the Erie County Housing Authority.

(1) Mrs. Weaver opened the meeting stating this is the final public hearing for the fiscal year 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$307,122 to undertake activities which address community development and/or housing needs which principally benefit low-to-moderate income persons. The amount of funds proposed to benefit low- and moderate-income persons is not less than 70%.

(A) Based upon a public needs hearing and a review of project requests, the City proposes that its FY 2022 CDBG funds be used for the following activities:

• Storm Sewer Separation Project	\$243,122
• Code Enforcement Officer Partial Salary	\$ 40,000
• Program Administrator	<u>\$ 24,000</u>
Total	\$307,122

(B) Mrs. Lindstrom asked what areas we would be focusing on for the storm sewers. Mrs. Weaver said that the City Engineer is looking at what money will be used up from the 2021 grant related to storm sewers and he will be seeing if any of the 2022 funding will need to go towards that. He is still working on what the next project will be. Mr. Fike commented that we should focus on areas with more runoff.

(C) Chuck Gray, Impact Corry, spoke with information and a request for funding to go towards Façade Renovation. Mrs. Weaver stated that we are out of time for any changes to this year's application. After a brief discussion, it was decided that Impact Corry would have to wait and apply for funding from the 2023 grant.

(D) Mrs. Lindstrom asked for clarification regarding the Program Administrator funds. Mrs. Weaver explained – that amount is taken out of the grant to compensate them for administering the grant.

(2) The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
